

HOW TO APPLY FOR DOCTORAL STUDIES

Download a PDF Admissions Application Packet for Doctoral Programs

Prerequisites:

Applicants for the **Doctor of Ministry** degree are to have an accredited M.Div. degree or its equivalent. Applicants for the **Doctor of Educational Ministry** degree are to have an accredited M.A.C.E. degree or its equivalent. Specific requirements for admission to doctoral programs are outlined in the appropriate doctoral degree guide, which is available from the Doctoral Studies Office.

A 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale in graduate level studies and 3 years post-graduate degree ministry experience is required.

Required Information:

The following items are needed to be admitted:

- Application Form
- \$25 Application Fee
- Letter of Church Endorsement
- Health, Social & Emotion well-being Form
- Three Recommendation Forms
- College and Seminary Official Transcripts
- Applicant Essay (8-10 pages double spaced)

Additional information needed (if applicable):

- Spouse Consent Form
- Divorce Essay
