The **Master of Arts in Theological Studies (MATS)** is a 15 course/45 credit hour degree program that is offered entirely online offered by Midwestern Baptist College, SBC the college division of Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary. The MATS degree is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. Restrictions apply to the number of online credit hours a student may use to satisfy MDiv, MACE, MACM, MACO, MA-BA or –BL degree requirements.

MATS now offers a MATS with Missions Emphasis. Some of the courses offered in Spring Terms A and B are specifically for that track. Note that the missions practicum courses are restricted to either IMB or NAMB personnel only. Before registering for a course, be sure it meets the requirements for your specific degree plan. Students may enroll in a maximum of two MATS online courses per term without obtaining approval of their advisor and the director of the MATS program.
