Enrolling for COMPUTER-CAMPUS-COMPUTER (CCC) COURSES—CCC courses begin with preparation by the student from home via the computer/e-mail for four-weeks; followed by one-week of intensive lectures on campus in Kansas City. The student then returns home to finish course requirements via the computer/e-mail. Students are to provide their e-mail address when they enroll for a CCC course. Students without e-mail capability may not enroll in CCC courses.

PAYING FEES

Pre-enrolling: **Continuing** (currently enrolled) **students** may pre-enroll for a CCC course during the regular pre-enrollment period each fall and spring semester. Pre-enrolling after the pre-enrollment period will result in the student being assessed the \$50 late pre-enrollment fee. Students may “late” pre-enroll through the Monday four weeks prior to the first on-campus class session. **New or reenrolling students** may pre-enroll anytime following the continuing student pre-enrollment period through the Monday four weeks prior to the first on-campus class session.

FEES DUE/Registering for classes Summer tuition and fees are due by the first day of class for courses beginning before May 31, 2011. Tuition and fees for other courses are due Tuesday, May 31, 2011 except for CCC courses for which fees are due four weeks prior to the first on-campus session or the date pre-coursework for CCC courses begins (see course offerings/schedule above).

Late Registration: To register for a CCC course after the Monday four weeks prior to the first on-campus class session and before the Monday three weeks prior to the first on-campus class session, students must obtain permission from the course professor prior to enrolling for the course. The student is responsible to obtain a copy of the course syllabus from the course professor and to complete all pre-course assignments. Students registering late are also assessed the \$50 late payment fee. **Students may not enroll in a CCC course with less than three weeks remaining before the first on-campus class session.**

REFUNDS FOR TUITION OF CCC COURSES (The Registration and other fees are non-refundable)

- 100% Withdrawal or drop through the end of the day four weeks prior to the first on-campus class session.
- 90% Withdrawal or drop during the four weeks prior to the first on-campus class session.
- 50% Withdrawal or drop on the day of the first class session.
- 25% Withdrawal or drop on the second day of classes.
- 0% After the end of the second day of classes.

Course Syllabi will be posted on Blackboard, <http://online.mbts.edu>, and in the library, as soon as they are available (but no later than 6 weeks prior to the CCC courses and 2 weeks prior to the first class of regular semester courses). Syllabi are to be downloaded, or obtained from the library for a nominal fee, for use on the first day of class or for CCC courses, the day pre-coursework begins. GRADES DUE

Grades are due in the Registrar’s Office six weeks following the last on-campus class session (i.e., the student has four weeks to complete post-class session assignments and the professor has two additional weeks to grade them).
