2014-2015 Academic Catalog Addendum

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The Addendum for the 2014-2015 Academic Catalog describes changes that apply to all students enrolling at Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary.

DEGREE MODIFICATIONS

MN310 Sermon Preparation replaces MN311 Sermon Delivery as a required class for the Associate of Divinity, Bachelor of Arts, Biblical Studies (including all corresponding double majors), Bachelor of Arts, Christian Ministry and Divinity, and Bachelor of Arts, Christian Ministry, Missions Emphasis and Divinity degrees.

NEW DEGREE OBJECTIVES for MDIV & MATS

Changed the language of degree program objective 1 in all the Master of Divinity and Master of Arts in Theological Studies programs from “demonstrate increased biblical and theological knowledge” (MATS) and “develop increased biblical and theological knowledge” (MDiv) to read “demonstrate sufficient biblical and theological knowledge.”

Changed the language of degree program objective 5 in the Master of Divinity from “develop a Great Commission perspective that is demonstrated by skills in evangelism, equipping disciples, preaching and teaching, corporate worship, and leadership to read “demonstrate a Great Commission perspective that is evidenced by skills in evangelism, equipping disciples, preaching and teaching, corporate worship, and leadership.”

Changed the language of degree program objective 5 in the Master of Arts in Theological Studies from “develop a Great Commission perspective that finds expression in evangelism, missions, and commitment to local church ministry to read “demonstrate a Great Commission perspective that finds expression in evangelism, missions, and commitment to local church ministry.”
