APPLICATION FOR RE-ADMISSION

Who may use the Re-Admission Application:

1. Students who have completed a degree at Midwestern and wish to re-apply for another degree (graduate or undergraduate) may use the Application for Re-Admission to apply if it is 12 months or less from the date they finished class to the date they would start classes again. If the student is out over 12-consecutive months, the student must go through the full application process. Please note that students must contact the Doctoral Office for information about applying for a doctoral program.
2. Students who delay enrolling for classes after acceptance or students wishing to resume studies after dropping out for a time do not have to complete any additional paperwork if they resume within 12 months. After 12 months have elapsed, these students must complete the renewal application.

An application for re-admission includes the following items:

1. Completed application form. The essay requested in the application form should be typed and attached.
2. Church endorsement form completed by the applicant's current church.
3. A Pastor reference.
4. An academic reference (collegiate level or higher)
5. Official transcripts from each academic institution attended since applying to Midwestern. These must be sent directly from the institution attended to Midwestern's Admissions Office.

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All items are to be received by the Admissions Office at least thirty days prior to the term for which you apply and are " valid for one year.
