Hearson has served as an associate pastor of small groups at Crossroads Community Church in Cincinnati, Ohio, and been a member of the faculty at Columbia Evangelical Seminary. His research interests include: "sacred space in the Bible and Rabbinic Literature" and "the problem of evil in the prophetic literature."
