## FORMER MBTS PRESIDENT, COPPENGER, TO SPEAK IN CHAPEL Tuesday, Oct. 20



Dr. Mark Coppenger, former MBTS president from 1991 – 1995, is the pastor of Evanston Baptist Church in Evanston, Ill. In addition to pastoring, he is the Distinguished Professor of Apologetics at the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, directs the Baptist Campus Ministry at Northwestern University, and is managing editor of the online Kairos Journal. Before attending seminary, he taught at Wheaton and Vanderbilt, where he directed a project for the National Endowment for the Humanities. He has authored, edited, or contributed to books by Broadman & Holman,

Prentice-Hall, Baker, Crossway, and Word. Coppenger also served as pastor of First Baptist Church, El Dorado, Ark.; executive director of the State Convention of Baptists in Indiana; chairman of the SBC Resolutions Committee; and short-term mission volunteer to Brazil, Russia, Romania, Belgium, and Egypt. He and his wife, Sharon, have two sons and a daughter.

## DRAPER TO BRING CHAPEL MESSAGE Wednesday, Oct. 21



Dr. Jimmy Draper is President Emeritus of LifeWay Christian Resources. Until Feb. 1, 2006, he was the President and C.E.O. for 15 years. He received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Baylor University as well as a Bachelor's and Master's degree in Divinity from Southwestern Seminary. He also holds doctoral degrees from Howard Payne, Dallas Baptist and Campbell Universities. From 1956 to 1991, he pastored churches in Texas, Oklahoma and Missouri. In missionary service, Draper has traveled to 36 countries leading evangelistic services, activities, conferences and meetings with missionaries and nationals. Among other achievements, he served as President, Southern Baptist Convention and Trustee Chairman for the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. He has authored numerous books including The Church Christ Approves, Foundations of Biblical Faith and most recently, Difficult Times; Encouraging Words. Draper and his wife, Carol Ann, have three children and six grandchildren.
