**MBTS Drop Policy**

**The add/drop policy for an 8 week class is as follows:**

% of tuition refund	Timeline
100%	Withdrawal or drop by 4:30 pm the fifth day of the term
50%	Withdrawal or drop after the first Friday (4:30pm) of an eight-week term through the Friday (4pm) of the second week of a term.
0%	Withdrawal or drop after then end of the second week of the term.

Students who withdraw during the first three weeks of a course will receive a grade of “W” (Withdrawn). **Students may not drop or withdraw from an online course after the third week, and will receive a failing grade if they do not successfully complete the course.** Because our courses are only eight weeks in length, the drop dates come quickly. The student is responsible to make himself aware of this drop policy and schedule.

Participation in an online learning environment is vital to the successful completion of a course of study. In the event of a computer or internet failure on the student’s system, the student must inform the course professor as soon as possible. The student is responsible to make arrangements to continue in the course while repairing the technology problems or resolving the situation that may have arisen. If you find yourself falling behind in your course work due to extenuating circumstances, it is your responsibility to communicate with your facilitator about your situation.
