Course Numbers & Descriptions

BS2210 Old Testament Survey I

An expositional survey of the Pentateuch and the Historical Books.

BS2211 Old Testament Survey II

An expositional survey of Wisdom, Poetry, and the Prophets.

BS2310 New Testament Survey I

An expositional survey of the Gospels and the book of Acts.

BS2311 New Testament Survey II

An expositional survey of Romans through Revelation.

BS2400 Introduction to Hermeneutics

A study of the principles of interpretation focusing on the application of principles and methods.

HT3100 History of Christianity I

A study of the history of Christianity from its beginnings to the Renaissance.

HT3101 History of Christianity II

A study of the history of Christianity from the Reformation to the present.

HT3200 Theology I

An introduction to the foundations of Christian theology. The nature of theology, its methods, and its sources are discussed and assessed. Special attention is given to the doctrines of revelation, Scripture, and God.

HT3201 Theology II

A continuation of 3200. Special attention is given to the doctrines of the person and work of Christ and salvation. Included are the doctrines of reconciliation, redemption, the church, and eschatology.

MS7011 Missiology

A study of the theology and philosophy of the Christian world mission with an emphasis on the biblical basis of missions, the doctrinal foundations of missions, the issues that are impacting missions today, and an overview of Southern Baptist missions.

MN5475 Personal Leadership Practicum

This course is designed to develop personal leadership competencies that encourage self-awareness and a confidence in a Christ-centered leadership approach that builds healthy, growing leaders for the church and her ministries.

MN5070 Evangelism and Discipleship Practicum

This course develops leadership competencies of gospel-awareness, personal evangelism, and discipleship, directing participants to a faithful, intentional lifestyle of communicating the gospel to non-believers and believers.

MN5476 Church Leadership Practicum

This course develops leadership competencies related to leading communities and congregations, directing participants to be long-term, 'reflective practitioners' who follow Jesus, as well as multiply leaders who will do the same.

MN5005 Spiritual Formation Practicum

This course develops leadership competencies of historical, biblical, and personal awareness of the spiritual life in the community while directing participants to an intentional lifestyle and ever-deepening relationship with Christ and his church.

HT3245 Theological Formation Practicum

This course develops competence in understanding and expressing sound and contextually relevant doctrine, with special reference to models found in the history of biblical interpretation.
