

Kalita Wave 185¹

What you need:

Kalita 185

Kalita 185 filters

Burr grinder

Digital Scale and Timer

Range Server

Kettle with a pouring spout

Your favorite mug

Amount of Coffee:

25 grams

Grind Size:

Varies, but generally medium (10-14 on a Baratza Encore)

Water:

400 grams of 205°F

Brew Time:

3:00-3:30 minutes

Steps:

1. Place filter in the Kalita Wave and rinse filter to heat vessel and to remove paper taste. Discard water.
2. Weigh 25 grams of coffee and grind to medium (10-14 on Baratza Encore)
3. With Kalita and server vessel on the scale, add coffee in Kalita and shake to level the coffee bed.
4. Zero out the scale.
5. Start timer and pour at the same time.
6. Split pouring into six separate pours of around 65-70 grams of water in 15 seconds and allow it to drain for 15 second between each pour. Do this until you reach 400 grams.
7. For each pour, begin in the center and make concentric circles, working your way out and back into the center. Be sure to cover the dark spots on the surface.
8. The brew should be finished around 3-3:30 minutes.
9. Enjoy your coffee!
